**Courses/Programmes**

Aligning with vision and mission of Lingnan University, LIFE has strived its excellence to offer

learning programmes to the community including language enhancement, industry skills

upgrade for professional development and recognition. Some of the key programmes are

listed as follows:

a. The LingnanU Elder Academy, which provides programmes for the elderly to learn and

interact with the younger generation through the sit-in of bachelor's degree

programmes and other practical courses.

b. Navigation Scheme for Young Persons in Care Services, provides the young people who

are interested to work in the elderly and rehabilitation care services to develop their

profession through on-the-job training.

c. Collaboration with industry partners to offer the practical and professional knowledge

in health, insurance, languages, mediation and facilities management.

We also support the Continuing Education Fund (CEF) which was first launched by the

government in 2002 with a view to encouraging local workers to pursue further education by providing adults keen on further education with subsidies for continuing education and training. Therefore, most of our programmes with Qualifications Framework Level offered are CEF reimbursable courses.

## **Quality Assurance**

LIFE has established a robust quality assurance mechanism to ensure the programme quality is well in place. Each new course/programme is initiated and considered by Lifelong Learning Programme Team, endorsed by relevant Academic Committees before finally approved by the respective panel.
